MAYOR JENNINGS ANNOUNCES: CAPITAL HILLS AT ALBANY GOLF COURSE PASSES AND RESIDENT ID CARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE THIS WEDNESDAY

Albany, NY – Mayor Jennings announced today that the Capital Hills at Albany Golf Course golf passes and resident ID's will be available starting Wednesday, March 19 2008 at the Capital Hills Pro Shop located at 65 O'Neil Road.

The hours of operation, until the golf course opens, are as follows:

Monday-Friday	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Saturday	10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The 2008 rates for passes will remain the same as last year.
\$100.00 for a Junior Season Permit (to 17 years of age)
\$100.00 for a Senior Season Permit (60 Years of age +)
\$250.00 for an Adult Season Permit

In order to obtain a resident ID card, you must provide three forms of identification, all of which must bear the same address. One must be a valid NYS Driver's License with a current address.

Residents must present a valid resident card to receive appropriate resident rates. An \$8 weekday and \$10 weekend co-payment must be paid in addition to the season permit fee.
