



City of Albany **Household Hazardous Waste & Electronics Drop-off Days**

As in years past Albany residents will have multiple chances to dispose of their household hazardous and electronic waste in an environmentally safe way. Residents must pre-register by calling toll-free **1-800-494-CARE (2273)**. Only residents of the City of Albany are eligible to participate. However, small businesses that generate less than 32 gallons a month of hazardous waste may also take advantage of this opportunity, but will be charged a small fee.
